

“Freak the Mighty” Final Project

First, choose one of the following options for your final project on “Freak the Mighty.”

- _____ Retell the story of *Freak the Mighty* as a children’s picture book.
- _____ Write a poem about *Freak the Mighty* and create a diorama (3-D scene) in a box.
- _____ Draw and color a map of the story’s setting and write about the characters, plot, and conflict next to the buildings/locations for *Freak the Mighty*.

As you make your project, you need to include information on each of the following. This should not be written as a separate report, but should be accomplished WITHIN your choice of project.

For example: If you decide to make a children’s book, use the children’s book images to show the setting and help describe the character, while the children’s book text will explain the conflict, characters, plot, and theme.

- The important settings in *Freak the Mighty* and how they changed the conflict in the story.
- The main conflicts in the story and which conflict led to the climax of the story.
- The main characters and how their personality (character traits) contributed to the story’s conflict, plot, and resolution.
- A summary of the plot (all the major events of the story from beginning to end). Identify the rising action, climax, and resolution.
- An explanation of the story’s theme and what the author wanted you to take away from the book, learn from the book, understand from the book, etc.
